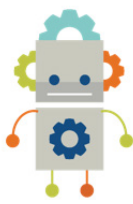

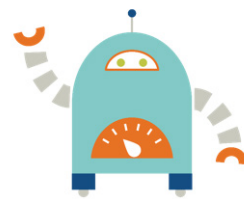


What is your largest challenge with Process Automation?

The repetitive process list can go on and on...

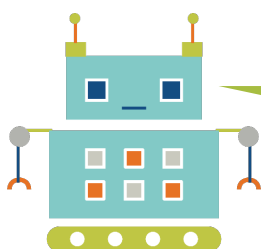
What repetitive processes does your PMO conduct today?

- Generating reports (e.g. comparing % complete vs % of project budget spent)
- Updating planned start date for future projects that don't get started on time
- Analyzing resource usage (who is working more/fewer hours than planned)
- Status report quality reviews and data integrity check
- Portfolio Management and tracking
- Human skills planning
- Meeting Scheduling

- Project intake
- Lessons learned
- Quarterly and annual reports
- Schedule review and analysis
- Invoice/financial reconciliation
- Auditing for reporting requirements
- Project staffing is somewhat of a repeatable process
